The Hall

Yellowbird Community League offers a bright window lit hall with an adjoining kitchen. The kitchen is equipped with a commercial dishwasher, fridge, and two stoves. The bar room has a small freezer, wine cooler etc. Folding chairs and 5-ft circular tables are available for use. The hall capacity is 180 standing or 150 seated people. A multi-purpose room and furnished board room are also available for rent for smaller meetings or events.

Yellowbird Community League can host most events — family celebrations, corporate planning sessions, community meetings, social events.

We have more than 40 raised cedar beds, at various heights. While most are about 18" high, a few are as tall as 30" and are offered to gardeners with mobility challenges. We have in-ground seasonal water taps for easy watering, and a long row of fruit trees on the surrounding berm. We also have a beautiful wooden gazebo as a focal and gathering point, which is often used for shade, casual conversation, and outdoor music festivals and community events.
